

Using Safari to View RSS

1. Click the *Safari* icon on the Dock and enter www.cnn.com in the *Address Bar*.
2. Click the blue RSS icon at the far right of the Address Bar. A list of articles on the page appears containing a description and a “Read more...” link. Notice that the URL now begins with *feed://* instead of the familiar *http://*.
3. Create a bookmark of the feed and repeat with [espn](http://espn.com), [usatoday](http://usatoday.com), and [wired](http://wired.com).

Using Safari to Read Multiple RSS Feeds

1. Pull down the *Safari* menu to *Preferences* and click the RSS button. Verify that *Default RSS Reader* is set to Safari, that both *Bookmarks Bar* and *Bookmarks Menu* are checked, and enter desired choices for the rest. Close preferences.
2. Pull down *Bookmarks* to *Add Bookmark Folder* and create a folder to store your RSS bookmarks. Drag the folder in the *Bookmarks Menu*. Drag the feed bookmarks previously created into this folder. Drag future feed URLs there.

Using Safari to Create an RSS “Search”

1. Pull down the *Bookmarks* menu to the folder you create to *View All RSS Articles* and enter “technology” as a search term in the *Search Articles* field.
2. The search term will remain in the search field even if you surf away from the page or quit Safari. As new articles are published, the search will be automatically updated!

Using Netvibes.com as a Web-Based RSS Reader

1. To set up your account, go to www.netvibes.com, click *Sign In* (upper right corner), and click the *Sign up now!* button.
2. When signup is complete, click *Type your Page Title Here* and enter page title.
3. To select a different “look,” click *Settings* (upper right), click *Themes* in the Settings column, and choose your theme. You are now ready to add your preferred feeds to your own RSS feed page.

Add, Removing, and Modifying Feeds in Netvibes

1. To add a feed from the provided *Feed Directory*, click *Add Content* (top left), select category (under *Browser Categories*), and browse to select the desired feed. Then drag it onto the Netvibes window.
2. To add a feed not on the list, click *Add a feed* (upper left), enter the feed URL into the box, and click *Add*.
3. To remove a feed, point to the feed title bar and click the close icon (x).
4. To modify a feed, by point to the feed title bar, and click *Edit*.
5. To create tabs for new categories in Netvibes, click *New Tab* (to the right of existing tab) and enter a name.
6. To move feed to a different location, point to the title bar and drag when the move icon (crossed arrows) appears. Move feeds to other tabs in same manner.
