

Using float with images

- 1 Open *splice.htm* from the *Splices* folder. Create a new *Class* called **.starpic** in *text.css*. In the *Box* category, set *Float* to **left**.
- 2 Click before **Workshops** and insert **orangestar.gif** from the *images* folder (inside *spice* folder.)
- 3 Select *orangestar.gif* and in the *Properties* window, set *width* to **44**, *height* to **40**, and *Class* to **starpic**.
- 4 Repeat steps 2-3 with **My Friends@FETC**.
- 5 Repeat steps 2-3, placing the image at the beginning of the text of each paragraph in the far right column. Set the *width* to **28**, the *height* to **24**, and the *Class* to **starpic**.
- 6 Insert a full sized version of the star in the first column between *Workshops* and *Downloads* (no *Class* this time.) Add line breaks (shift + enter) before and after this image as desired. Save and preview.

Using box margins for spacing

- 7 Highlight the heading in the middle column and insert a div with a new *Class* style: **mainHeadline**.
- 8 In the *CSS Rule Definition* window enter the following settings (and then click **OK** and save)

Creating inverse text

- 10 Create a new class in the *CSS* window named **.headerInverse**. with the following settings and then using the *Properties* window, apply this new style to **Topics** and **Meet the Presenter**.

Creating a pull quote

- 11 Click in the *Meet the Presenter* section just before the sentence that begins: *In fact he is ...* and insert a new div with a new *Class* style: **pullQuote** having the following settings:

- 12 Copy the sentence from the *Presenter* section that begins *He stays busy...* Click inside the pullquote DIV, highlight the placeholder text if necessary and pull down *Edit to Paste Special to Text Only*.
- 18 Save and preview in browser.

Attaching a style sheet, using styles in other files, and changing style for the site

- 19 In *Dreamweaver*, open the file *downloads.htm* from the *Spice* folder and click the *Attach Style Sheet* icon (chain link) located in the lower right of the *CSS* window. Browse to find *text.css* in the *Spice* folder and click **Choose**.
- 20 Highlight all of the text in the sidebar menu box and insert a new div, entering **sidebarText** in the *Class* field and click **OK**.
- 21 Apply some additional styles from *text.css* to this page.
- 22 Edit the style *basictext* in the *CSS* window by changing the size of the text to **16**. Save the *downloads* file and preview both it and *spice.htm* in the browser. Notice it is changed for all.
- 23 Experiment with other changes and observe how they are applied.
